The Executive Committee consists of members who are either elected to office or appointed to serve as committee chairs.

Offices include:

President;
1st Vice President – Educational Programs;
2nd Vice President – Membership;
2nd Vice President – Publications;
Secretary;
Treasurer; and
NALA Liaison.

Elected officers serve the association for 1-year terms. Elections are held at the end of the calendar (and fiscal) year. Elected officers are officially installed upon taking an oath at the annual meeting in January.

Chairs are appointed by the President, and they too serve 1-year terms.
